TERROIR & VARIETIES

This Côtes du Rhône Villages is a selection of Grenache and Syrah grapes from specific terroirs of Côtes du Rhône Villages. We created an outstanding balance between two different terroirs: clayed sandy soils bring finesse, freshness and elegance. Signargues' terraces of cobbles, over an old Rhône river bed, offer minerality and body.

WINEMAKING

The blend is 80 % Grenache and 20% Syrah. Each variety is vinified individually to develop their own characteristics. The vatting lasts 3 to 4 weeks according to the grape variety and then undergoes malolactic fermentation.

The Syrah is aged in French oak barrels for 12 months and the Grenache spends 12 months in tank before blending.

TASTING NOTES

An aroma of earthy spices and ripe red fruit jumps from the glass. Blackcurrant and black pepper come through on the palate with a hint of minerality. Smooth tannins linger on the rich finish.

SERVING TIPS

We recommend serving it between 13° and 15°C with grilled steak, BBQ, smoked ham and other full-flavored dishes worthy of a King's table. Delicious now, it can be enjoyed over the next 5 to 6 years of age.

VINTAGE 2019

High quality, low yields. The harvest started mid-September and took place until early October. Thanks to scattered rains over the period, maturities progressed smoothly, allowing for an ideal picking rythm. The warm summer provided a concentrated aromatic profile for the red wines. This vintage shows charm and elegance with remarkable balance.
